'Clean Energy Future for Bethlehem' Energy Task Force Program Set

BETHLEHEM - The Energy Task Force will present Clean Energy Future for Bethlehem at 10 a.m. Saturday, May 15, at Memorial Hall.

Energy Task Force members Cassandra Beauvais, Carolyn Humphreys, Fred Merrill and Jack Nelson will focus on the Home Energy Solutions Program, which provides an expert home energy audit; free energy-saving items and services, such as compact fluorescent lights and caulking; and potential savings of hundreds of dollars in energy costs and rebates for a modest co-pay.

In the second part of the program, task force members will explain Bethlehem's plan to support the development of more clean, renewable energy sources and how that can be accomplished economically.

In December 2009, the Board of Selectmen voted to join 96 other Connecticut municipalities in pledging that 20 percent of the power for town facilities would come from renewable energy (regional wind, hydroelectric, solar) by the end of 2010.

The purpose of the voluntary program is to support renewable sources for future energy security and a cleaner environment for Connecticut.

Residents can support clean energy and earn credits toward free solar panels for town buildings by signing up for clean energy options, which offset the use of coal, oil, nuclear and gas with regional wind and hydroelectric power.

The task force will explain how the renewable energy option can be selected and still save on electricity bills by taking advantage of the competitive electricity generation market.

Home Energy Solutions and the free solar panel program are supported through the Connecticut Energy Efficiency Fund and the Connecticut Clean Energy Fund, both paid for by a small proportion of each electric rate-payer's bill.

Money-making promotions for clubs, religious groups and organizations that run their own sign-up campaigns for Home Energy Solutions or Connecticut Clean Energy Options will also be discussed.

The task force will be available for questions and will meet individually with groups on request.
