**Modification to the On-Site Renewable DG Program – Commercial
 Solar /For Profit Project Incentive**

Effective April 1, 2008

On March 31, 2008, the Board of Directors of the Connecticut Clean Energy Fund approved a modification to the On-Site Renewable DG Program’s Commercial Solar /For Profit Incentive. The incentive for commercial solar for profit projects, including projects owned by third parties, was capped at a max of \$5 /Watt_(ptc). Effective April 1, 2008, the CCEF will offer grants using the following incentive structure.

**Declining Block Incentive Structure –
 OSDG Program Commercial Solar/For Profit**

Incentive Blocks	Max Incentive - PTC /Watt	Max Incentive - PTC /Watt (LEED Certified)
<100 kW	\$4.75	\$5.00
>100 kW but <200 kW	\$4.25	\$4.50
>200 kW but <300 kW	\$3.75	\$4.00
>300 kW (w/ avg. annual peak during 11am – 3pm	\$3.00	\$3.25
>300 kW (w/ avg. annual peak outside of 11am – 3pm	\$2.00	\$2.25

Other components of the On-site Renewable DG Program pertaining to Commercial Solar / For Profit projects have not changed: i.e. 500 kW(ptc) project max size, total max grant of \$2.5 million and no single project owner (individual or corporate entity, including parent companies) will receive more than \$4 million in incentives in any three-year period. Commercial Solar / For Profit applications currently in the CCEF’s pipeline (project that have filed Pre-applications or Applications) will qualify under the old incentive structure for 60 days from April 1, 2008.
